

Muscoda Public Library Mission and Goals Statement

A. The mission of the Muscoda Public Library shall be:


1. To assemble, preserve, and administer in organized collections books and related educational and recreational material in order to promote through guidance and stimulation the communication of ideas, an enlightened citizenship, and enriched personal lives.
2. To provide access to informational, educational, cultural, and recreational library materials and services in a variety of formats and technologies.
3. To be responsive to the public library needs of the community and area served.
4. To uphold the public's freedom of access to information.

B. The general library goals of the Muscoda Public Library shall be:

1. To serve all residents of the community and the surrounding region.
2. To acquire and make available to all residents such books, periodicals and other services as will address their needs to: become well informed, locate answers to important questions, cultivate the imagination and creative expression, develop skills for career and vocational advancement, and enjoy leisure by means of reading and other media services.
3. To acquire the means to provide the most frequently requested material locally and upon demand.
4. To maintain a program of service which locates information, guides reading, organizes and interprets material for people of various backgrounds, and stimulates thinking and intellectual development in individuals of any age.
5. To strive consistently to discover new methods and improvements for better service for the library's customers.
6. To review regularly these goals of the Muscoda Public Library and, if necessary, revise them in the light of new developments.
